President's *Message*

Tonia and I were looking forward to the dance in Hot Springs on August 1st. Arkansas hit an all-time high with COVID-19 cases on July 11th, and the safety of all our dancers is always on the forefront of any discussions we have. The ASSDF officers reviewed the circumstances, and have decided to **postpone** the dance until May of 2021, **tentatively** set for Saturday, May 1st in Hot Springs. The Double Tree by Hilton in Hot Springs has been very understanding and gracious to us, and simply allowing us to move the date. Plus, Charlie Robertson from Oklahoma has agreed to join us on May 1st, as well.

On a much more positive note, we are continuing our series on officers of the ASSDF, and getting to know everyone better. Sheila and Rick Gesing are our ASSDF Treasurer, and this is their first year to serve as an ASSDF officer. Though relatively new to square dancing as a couple, they literally hit the ground running (dancing), and have not looked back.

dancers. Rick and Sheila want to thank all of their square dancing friends that have helped them rapidly develop their skills.

We originally thought the ASSDF dance in October was out there far enough that we would not even think about having to postpone or cancel, however, now we can only wait and see.

As I think everyone would agree, we all look forward to getting back to dancing!! Just regret that Covid 19 showed up and will cause us all to have to have refresher classes. I bet everyone will be pleasantly surprised with what we remember!

As noted, the Delegates Meeting and Dance has been **POSTPONED**, tentatively set for May 1, 2021; the rest of the dance schedule remains the same (see the flier in this issue for more info). Last minute cancellations can be sent via email blasts, and Twitter; those who receive these updates, should notify those in their club who do not.

While some clubs have resumed dancing (some with masks and gloves); most clubs remain dark. PLEASE CALL BEFORE YOU TRAVEL, as many of the Special Dances in The Modern Square, and on the websites, may get cancelled. Please advise of any changes to your clubs' status; and, if you feel leery of getting out...or are not feeling well, please stay home.

The 2021 National Square Dance Convention (NSDC), will be in Jackson, Mississippi. Future NSDC's are in Evansville, Indiana in 2022; in Mobile, Alabama in 2023; and in Milwaukee, Wisconsin in 2024. I've placed links to PDF files for these on the websites (note the deadlines on the forms). Some of the pictures in the e-Edition this month (from Carolyn Birdsong) are from the 2014 NSDC in Little Rock.

If you haven't received the free e-Edition, you either aren't signed up for it, or your email bounced as undeliverable. 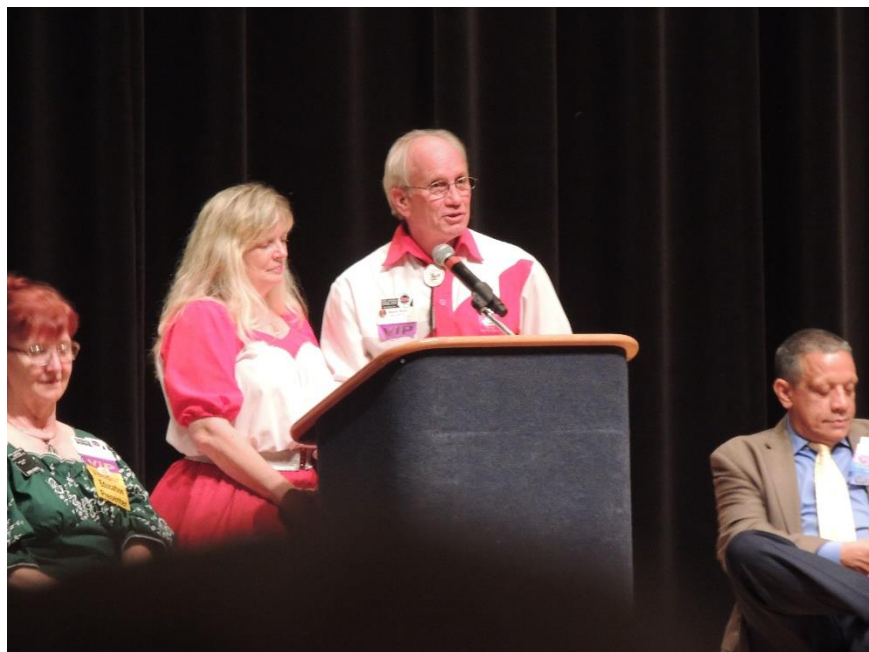
