## President's Message

### **INSURANCE FOR ALL CLUBS IS DUE!**

Clubs may mistakenly believe that their callers' insurance is an umbrella for their club; unfortunately that's not the case. I talked to Mac Letson, Executive Director, American Callers Association. **ACA** callers are covered and dancers "only if the caller directly causes injury". He agreed dancers need insurance, such as **USDA** insurance. I pulled this from the **CALLERLAB** web site: "It protects **CALLERLAB**, and you, the caller. **These policies do not cover the dancers.**"

We're covered by the world's largest square dance organization, the **USDA Dancers Insurance Program**. To quote the **USDA**, "Every square dance organization needs General Liability and Accident Medical Expense coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. It helps protect the club members from financial loss due to a covered accidental bodily injury, and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members...from financial loss due to unforeseen incidents which may develop into litigation against members and organizations."

Liability Insurance: \$1,000,000 combined single limit of liability for bodily injury and property damage. \$100,000 limit for damage to premises rented to you. Accident & Medical Insurance: \$10,000 usual and customary Accident Medical Expense, including Dental \$10,000. Accidental Death Benefit \$10,000.

**USDA** is a great resource for square dancing, to review the coverage in its entirety you can check out their web site: <http://www.usda.org/> -- if a club moves from its normal dance venue, it needs to be added and updated on your policy to have coverage.

Personally, I feel it's **important that every dancer in every club is covered** by General Liability and Accidental Medical coverage. \$5 per year per person

is extremely reasonable; and unfortunately in today's world, extremely important to have in case of any unforeseen accidents that may occur.

The Three Amigos (Gene, Phil, and Joey) are back in action on Saturday, January 1, 2022 at the American Legion Hut in Little Rock.

Remember to take time to do what's important. Spend time with family, friends, and your special friends you square dance with; and don't forget to go to church, and thank The Lord for the blessings we enjoy!

See you on the dance floor, and looking forward to a fantastic 2022!




