challenged the “same old same old” of the bylaws and how we operate. Yes ... sometimes I was over the top. However ... if that is what it took to wake people up, so be it. The Letter to the Editor from Ron Wise shows me that there are more voices out there that see the need to question the basis on which the ASSDF is operating and the need to find new ways to move forward. Take the time to read it. It is worthwhile.

Unlike many who sit around the snack table and complain, I got active. We now have a new set of By-laws. They are more representative of the situation we are in than the old. The new system will allow the organization to be more nimble and more focused. Thank you all for voting it into place at the Fall Delegates Meeting.

# Letter To The Editor

From Ron Wise

Once upon a time in Arkansas there were over 90 square dance clubs. Nearly every community of any size had one. In the Little Rock/North Little Rock area there were about 30 clubs. All over Arkansas, there was a dance within a short drive every night of the week and some nights there were several. The Modern Square had over a 1000 subscriptions. This suggests there must have been about 4000 dancers in Arkansas at that time. To make some sense of the resulting chaos, an organization like the ASSDF was essential and in order to manage a membership of that size it had to be rather robust, with well written by-laws and rules of order. It apparently did a good job. It had a large pool of members to draw enthusiastic volunteers. The legacy of that time is a Modern Square publication second to none in the nation and a Fall Festival which still draws a large crowd of in and out of state dancers.

Folks...THE TIMES HAVE CHANGED! Out of the 90 clubs a few years ago, we are down to about 15 and several of those are holding on by a thread. It's a slow death. As one club folds, others nearby sometimes pick up a few homeless dancers and sustain themselves a little longer. Sometimes offering a class picks up a few more dancers and the club squeaks through for another year or two. BUT, overall, our membership continues to age, die, or dropout due to frailties faster than new dancers are coming in. There is something wrong with the picture where Arkansas clubs are dying while the ASSDF is operating "Business as Usual". It is as if the ASSDF doesn't realize it is about to go out of existence. Maybe we are all in a bit of denial. However, it is far too late to be worrying about revising the by-laws and making controversial rules about who can belong and who can't and who can be listed in the Modern Square and who can't and whether clubs have the recommended insurance or not. It is too late to worry about all those ASSDF offices that are really no longer needed and for which nobody wants to volunteer. None of that will be important when the ASSDF expires because there aren't enough clubs left to support it. The ASSDF was a good thing. Nobody wants to give up on a good thing.

But I think most of us suspect (perhaps subconsciously) that the remaining 15 clubs are not getting much from the ASSDF. With so few clubs operating, a single sheet monthly newsletter could adequately keep track of who is dancing and when. And now, we don't even need the Fall Festival to have great dances to attend with the nation's greatest of callers. For example: Branson Blow Out; Branson Square 'Em Up; Paris, TX Chaparral; Wagoner, OK; Lake Degray, AR; and many more. National callers are now even willing to come to our little towns all over Arkansas. If we are going to sustain square dancing in Arkansas, we need an organization which will focus on promoting square dancing to the general public. This can be done by promoting and advertising. Examples:

1. Put regular and recurring ads in newspapers (local & LR area).
2. Organize Flash Mobs at malls & shopping centers around AR.
3. Air promotional and news releases on local radio stations regularly.
4. Distribute signs, flyers, news releases to local clubs for their use.
5. Sponsor & heavily advertise special "NO EXPERIENCE NEEDED" dance events in several areas around AR where we still have existing clubs.

I am sure there is much more we could do. How do we fund these activities?

1. Have fund raisers.
2. Collect dues from clubs based on their membership size and sponsor Feature Dances with National callers like Fall Festival.
3. Organize/encourage raiding/visitations between clubs to boost club revenue.

Can the ASSDF refocus toward promoting square dancing to the non-dancers of Arkansas or do we need to form a new organization before it is too late?

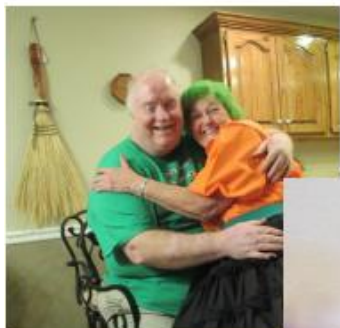
