#### From The Editor



First, a heartfelt message from Elaine Cox, of **NEODSA** (Northeast Oklahoma Square Dance Association), but this applies to **ALL** dancers, no matter where they are. **I couldn't have said this any better**.

\*\*

We need to support **all of our callers**, by attending their dances wherever they are held. Even if things are not exactly as we want them to be, our callers are showing up and doing their job. As dancers, we need to do the same.

Please don't stay away from dancing because of fear of controversy. During times of uncertainty, we can and should come together and be united to keep our hobby healthy and strong. Please attend every dance that you can. Consider attending dances you don't normally attend as a show of solidarity. We will make it through this. Our callers are staying steady. As dancers, we need to do what we always do; follow their lead.

Second, all clubs have related expenses for the maintenance, repair, and upkeep of their dance halls...never mind the fact that hall rents for regular dances and festivals, have skyrocketed. The "New Kids Block Party" dances at American Legion Post 128 (where the Twirling Lariats and Maverick Mixers dance (the only 2 ASSDF Clubs left in Little Rock)), has its proceeds going to "The Hut Repair Fund".

Two of the **ASSDF Clubs** are **OUTSIDE** of Arkansas, but they are nearby. These are the **Guys N Dolls** in New Boston, Texas...and the **Southern Swingers** in Bossier City, Louisiana. Hall costs in Texarkana had the **Guys N Dolls** move to New Boston, Texas...and the **Southern Swingers** were the host club to the recent **74**<sup>th</sup> **National Square Dance Convention** ® in Shreveport. Without them, there would only be **10** 

**ASSDF** clubs. So, when an **ASSDF** Club has a fund raiser dance for "dance facility upkeep", I'm going to promote it.

#### SMOOTH DANCING

#### BY BUDDY WEAVER

#### **Pre-Arranged Squares**

If you've been around square dancing for any length of time, you will have experienced pre-arranged squares, where four couples have filled all the spots in their square ahead of the caller asking to "square up". You may have been part of a pre-arranged square or you might have stepped into an open spot in a square only to have someone say "we're full" or "that spot is taken". In the former situation, you probably feel exuberance at the thought of dancing with your friends who are the best dancers. In the latter situation, you probably felt excluded and no matter how the message was delivered, it was received in a rude manner.

Pre-arranged squares are nothing new and perils of this practice are well documented.

#### Exclusion

When the same eight pre-book tips, newcomers are left out, undermining the "fun and fellowship" clubs aim to foster. This is especially harmful when a new graduate attends an open dance only to find they are excluded from squares, sometimes by the same "friendly angels" they know from class.

- Weaker Social Fabric
   Rotating squares is part of the social contract; pre-arranging reduces
   inter-club friendship building and cross-club visitor hospitality.
- Uneven Floor Ability = Programming Headaches
   Strong dancers clumping in one square can leave others struggling, making it harder for the caller to keep the hall moving smoothly. In more than one case, I have witnessed "set squares" of dancers who couldn't complete a single sequence without breaking down. In this case the pre-arranged squares joined the dancers who shouldn't be in a square together.
- Club Culture Erosion
   Multiple sources place "set squares" alongside behaviors that correlate with declining engagement (sitting out, not helping visitors, etc.).

I have witnessed clubs that had strong visitor attendance on a weekly basis transition to having almost no visitors simply because the club members wanted their squares to themselves.

There are some situations where pre-arranged squares are appropriate. In our club we ask every angel to be a mentor to a beginner at every dance. If the beginners are a couple, then the mentor is a couple; if the beginner is a single, then the mentor is a single. Since the mentors/angels know each other, they quickly bring the beginners into squares and introduce them to their friends. In this way the beginner is immediately made to feel included and part of the family.

If pre-arranged squares is causing folks to feel excluded, then it must go away before the club goes away. Some ideas to adopt encourage social mixing of the dancers are:

- Partner Rotation Boards. A system that is easy to set up and will give people a chance to dance with different partners in an organized way. Here is a link that describes Partner Rotation Boards: <a href="https://c-p-s-d.org/Documents/Rotation">https://c-p-s-d.org/Documents/Rotation</a> Board.pdf
- 2. Adapt a "mixing" norm. "Dance in different squares, not always with the same group". Printed and well displayed. In many countries outside of the US, the practice is to dance with your partner for the first and last tip but all others, you are dancing with someone else. After the "thank you" ending the tip, dancers turn and go get their new partner for the next tip.
- 3. Computer rotation systems. One of the most popular is from Vic and Debbie Ceder, Square Rotation Program can generate computer cards to print or generate a rotation prior to each tip. Link. Another rotation program is Swirls, while similar to Square Rotation Program, Swirls can be run using RFID cards and dancers can easily transition from dancing as a couple to dancing as a single (in the case where your partner wants to sit one out) or anybody choosing to sit out a tip. It is done without a computer operator dancers do it themselves using RFID cards. Link.

The USDA line—"discourage 'set squares' and cliques"—is authoritative and easy to reference in websites, and class handouts. To promote fellowship, discourage set/stacked squares and cliques. Please join the nearest forming square and mix partners and squares throughout the evening. Limit pre-arrangement for mentoring brand-new dancers with designated Angels on class nights and only for the purpose of **including** new dancers.

From Jean Coy, ASSDF USDA Insurance Coordinator - July 1, 2025

I attended a United Square Dancers Of America (USDA) Association Meeting, and an insurance meeting at the National Square Dance Convention ® (NSDC) in Shreveport, Louisiana, on June 25-26, 2025...both sponsored by the United Square Dancers Of America (USDA).

USDA has produced club leadership and educational materials to include webinars for use by dancers and leadership, to promote and perpetuate the dance activity. These webinars and handouts are stored, and can be viewed at any time at <a href="https://usda.org/">https://usda.org/</a> -- just look for the appropriate links. You may copy and distribute to other dancers, as the publication and educational materials are NOT copyrighted.

The Executive Committee of USDA is proud to provide a Centennial Awards Program for dancers in this age group. The qualified recipients will be given a nice framed "Certificate Of Recognition" signed by the President of USDA, and the Vice President of their region. They will also receive a "United Square Dancers Of America Centennial Award" lapel pin. This award will be presented to them by a member of the Executive Committee, at a dance attended by the recipient when possible. Should the recipient be able to attend the USDA Board Of Directors Meeting the day prior to the National Square Dance Convention ®, USDA will pay their convention registration. You have to be at least 100 years of age, and still dancing. Details on the award are at <a href="https://www.usda.org/Centinnal\_Award.php">https://www.usda.org/Centinnal\_Award.php</a>

The USDA awards merit-based scholarships to students who have shown their dedication to the promotion and perpetuation of the total square dance movement...including square dance, round dance, contra, and clogging...and

they are members of an affiliated club. For more information, please go to https://www.usda.org/Youth\_Dancing/

On Dec. 23, 2019, the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) recognized the United Square Dancers Of America, Incorporated, as a 501(c)(3) Non-Profit Group Exemption Administrator. This entitles affiliates of the USDA to be granted 501(c)(3) Non-Profit status, by submitting their application to the USDA Group Exemption Coordinator, rather than submitting their application to the IRS. Much like the current "Arkansas Traveler" program, the USDA has started a USA Traveler program. A badge and bar will be awarded to the participant(s) at no charge to them, after they have visited at least 12 states, and have a form signed and returned to the USDA to be verified. Additional colored bars will be awarded as follows:

24 States – White Bar
36 States – Blue Bar
48 States – Silver Bar

#### The Purpose of the Grant Program:

The Youth Dancing Grant Program was developed to Assist in the Involvement, Recruitment and Fostering of Youth Growth within the Square Dance Community. The Grant is funded by an outside source(s), but will rely on the USDA to Administer. The program will run each calendar year from January to January annually as long as there are funds available for the program.

#### **How the Grant Program Will Operate:**

When a club or Affiliate has a shortage of funds for a specific activity involving Youth, a request for a Grant to ASSIST in the shortfall may be sent to the USDA Youth Advisory Committee (<a href="www.Committee.usda.org">www.Committee.usda.org</a>). The Affiliate or Club agrees to use the funds as outlined in their request. Several examples of needs would be to help offset the costs for a group of Youth taking lessons (assisting their families), helping a group attending a State or National Convention with identified shortfalls, and help in identifying shortfalls while developing a Youth Program.

#### **The Application Process:**

A Club or Affiliate will need to submit an application for a grant when they anticipate that they will have a shortfall financially for their Youth activity. The application, once received, will be reviewed and approved or denied within 30 days of receipt. The Grant is not a free pass, the requesting organization needs to show what they have done to offset the identified shortfall. The Grant funds will be dispersed in the following incremental amounts: \$250.00, \$500.00, \$750.00 and \$1,000.00 as deemed necessary, per

the Grant request. The application will need to explain the shortfall, what the requestor has done to address the shortfall, what the funds will accomplish in offsetting the shortfall, and how many youth will be affected. There will be only one Grant per event, however an organization can apply for, and be considered for, any other grant needs that arise.

#### The Financial Process:

Once a Grant is approved, funds will be issued by the USDA Treasurer to the requesting organization. The requesting organization will be contacted for instructions on to whom to direct the funds.

#### In Addition:

Clubs are encouraged to submit suggestions that will help with the expansion of the Grant process. Helping Youth is the primary goal.

Note: In past years, the deadline has been February 1, with presentations being made at the upcoming National Square Dance Convention ®, but that appears to have changed this year.

So, if you'd like to apply for one of the USDA Founders Memorial Youth Fund Scholarship Program grants, please submit your application promptly.

Every dance organization needs insurance coverage while conducting and sponsoring dance activities. No matter how closely we follow safety rules and protocols, accidents can happen! United Square Dancers of America (USDA) offers comprehensive and affordable liability and supplemental medical insurance. This insurance program, specifically designed for USDA dance groups, provides Liability AND Accidental Medical insurance coverage.

Liability Insurance protects the club along with its members and officials from financial loss due to unforeseen incidents that may develop into litigation against members and dance organizations. This insurance is required by most of our dance facilities – those used regularly for club dances, as well as those used for special dance events or even demonstrations.





Accidental Medical Insurance provides coverage for injuries sustained while participating in dancing activities sponsored and supervised by a recognized club or organization. The insurance is "portable" – that is, it covers the insured dancer while participating in any

regularly scheduled and sponsored dancing activity worldwide.

If you see these emails, DELETE them. And, if you see these ads, DON'T click on ANY part of them. Instead, report them to the group administrators, so the post can be deleted, and the poster can be banned from the group. Then, BLOCK that person in your email spam filter, and your Facebook profile. This helps keep that spam off your page. If not, someone will get their identity/data stolen, your Facebook page could get hacked, or you could be "left on the hook, financially".

Ted learned to square dance in 1988 and began calling the same year. He began teaching classes in 1990s and has taught beginner calling classes every year since. He became the club caller for Tech Squares of MIT in 1997 and still teaches their 12-week Crash Course. Known for his smooth-flowing choreography and music usage, he calls Beginners through C1.

In 2017, Ted started his own music label and is the owner and producer of Throw Back Tunes and co-owns and produces TOTL Recordings with Tony Oxendine.

Ted has been a member of CALLERLAB since 1991 and earned Accredited Caller Coach designation in 2020. He has served on the CALLERLAB Board of Governors since 2018 and was elected to the Executive Committee in 2021. He was named CALLERLAB's Chairman of the Board in April 2023.

#### 75th NSDC's Leadership Certification Program

Interested in being a leader or learning to be a better one? Then the Leadership Certification Program is for you! The program can easily be completed during a single National Square Dance Convention® (NSDC) but you can take up to four years to finish. Upon completion you will receive a Certificate of Completion and a LCP dangle to proudly wear on your badge.

The Leadership Certification Program (LCP) consists of two mandatory classes, four core sessions, and two electives for a total of eight hours. There are around 43 hours of dancing and other activities during any NSDC so, if you start and finish the LCP, you



will still have around 35 hours to enjoy everything the Convention has to offer. However, if you are someone who loves taking classes, you can take as many as you wish as long as you get the basic number of each category completed.

The Mandatory Sessions include the Bid Session and the Keynote address. The Bid Session is an exciting presentation given by a state that wants to host an upcoming National Square Dance Convention. The presentation highlights many of the attractions in that city as well as providing information about the proposed venue. The second mandatory class is the Keynote Address given by a prominent member of the square or round dance community and addresses a timely and pertinent issue within the community. The Keynote Speeches can be so inspiring that participants leave with the knowledge they can make a difference.

Core Classes provide the participants with knowledge for effective administration of a square dance club or organization. These classes include insurance, using social media effectively, how to become a 501c3 organization, educational/informational pamphlets and videos available to clubs, various support organizations such as United Square Dancers of America (USDA), ARTS, and CALLERLAB as well as important topics of the current year.

Elective Classes cover a wide range of topics. Previous electives included seminars to help new callers build their skills, how to recruit and retain dancers, a slide presentation on the next year's convention, as well as seminars on making colorful and effective flyers, competition and exhibition square dancing, and histories of contra and square dancing.


