The **ASSDF Delegates Meeting and Dance**, is set for Saturday, May 1, at the Doubletree By Hilton on Lake Hamilton in Hot Springs; please see the flier in this issue for more info. All member clubs need to send at least 2 delegates to the meeting. At the dance, you can sign up or renew your **print subscription to The Modern Square**. The ASSDF **can't** continue absorbing the loss with the postage and printing costs, with the decline of print subscriptions, and lack of ads. Please contact me if you have questions about the website, or **The Modern Square**.

The **National Square Dance Convention (NSDC)** in Jackson, Mississippi, is set for June 23-26, 2021. At the NSDC, masks are required only when you're not dancing. Arkansas Governor Asa Hutchinson has noted that "if COVID-19 cases continue declining, the directives will change to guidelines as of April" (we hope that doesn't become an April Fool). People should continue wearing masks, social distancing, proper hygiene, etc.; and get vaccinated, if eligible. If supplies permit, it's possible that shots may be made available to all adult Arkansans by May. Please **call before you travel**, to be sure that the clubs are dancing that day or evening, and for any COVID-19 requirements. Some clubs require masks for the entire dance; while others have them at your discretion, or only when not dancing.



If you haven't received it by the 1st of the month (excluding Sundays and holidays), contact the Editor to be sure your print subscription hasn't expired (the date's on the mailing label on the back page), and that your mailing address is correct. If the subscription is current, and the mailing address is correct, then contact your Post Office, and ask where it is (mail delivery has been much slower than usual lately). Complain that you need The Modern Square, because of the dance dates within it.

The e-Edition is usually emailed by the 16th of each month. If your email is correct, then it's either in your spam folder, or your ISP is blocking it. You'll need a PDF viewer to read the e-Edition.
