
The Club Special Dance photos will be placed in a separate file each month, as will photos from recent **ASSDF Fall Festivals**.


In Loving Memory - Gene Gancarczyk













































To finish off with humor (as there is so little to laugh at these days).






I called a faux pas over the microphone at the square dance and one of the dancers yelled, "what level is that on?"


Cue the music "You're So Vain", that you think this sign is about you!!
