It's that time of year again, for all ASSDF Member Clubs to update their enrollment!!

As you are aware, the **ASSDF** is the central organization that helps guide square dancing in the state of Arkansas. In addition, the **ASSDF** puts on an annual Fall Festival, to bring the state dancers together under one roof, sponsors the **ASSDF** website (https://www.arkansassquaredance.com) to provide square dancing information to all individuals, publishes the monthly publication **The Modern Square** (e-Editions), letting all know what the Clubs are doing, and helps the clubs to obtain insurance through the **USDA Dancers Insurance Program**.

The 2026 Annual ASSDF Club Membership Fee is \$20, and it is due to the ASSDF Treasurer by January 1, 2026. Please make the check payable to the ASSDF, and mail it to:

IMPORTANT! In order for a Club to participate in the USDA Dancers Insurance Program, the Club must be a member of the ASSDF.

Clubs may feel that "their caller insurance" protects them from incidents/accidents at dances. However, according to Callerlab and the American Callers Association, it protects them "only if a caller causes injury". Your dance club and its members are at risk of a massive lawsuit if something happens at a dance, without insurance. However, the Dance Clubs may receive economical dancer insurance (per dancer) through the United Square Dancers of America. This insurance program provides Accident Medical

Insurance, which helps supplement a dancer's existing medical insurance; and Liability insurance, which protects the club and its members from financial loss due to unforeseen accidents, which may develop into litigation against members and organizations.

To review the **USDA Dancers Insurance Program** coverage in its entirety...including who and what is covered, limits of coverage, and period of coverage, among other items, go to https://www.usda.org/Insurance.php.

The USDA annual individual dancer premium will be \$6.50 for 2026...with a minimum charge of \$52 per club, which is based on 8 dancers (1 square). The USDA had to increase the cost due to the increased costs the insurance carrier has incurred. Every Club's Insurance Coordinator should have received the annual ASSDF insurance packet the week after November 15, 2025. If you did not receive the insurance mailout, please contact ASSDF Insurance Coordinator, Jean Coy, at (715) 207-3502.

In the insurance information packet, there will be a **blank club roster** form to designate the paying insurance members. Please note **any change** in the venue you dance at, or if there has been a change in the insurance contact personnel, when you return the roster. **Please remember if there are dancers within your club who are members of multiple clubs, the insurance fee will only be paid once**.

The **ASSDF** appreciates every clubs participation in our state organization and welcomes all feedback on how we can make the organization better to support the backbone of our organization...the Clubs!

Due to vision issues, I no longer drive, and can't be at dances, etc. unless someone offers transportation. Please advise me if your info (club contact, dance day/time) in The Modern Square or on the ASSDF website, is wrong; as I can't fix it if I'm not told.

Most of the special dance photos are from club Facebook groups, although not everyone is on Facebook. If nothing's sent in or posted, nothing's published in The Modern Square, or on the ASSDF website. There's no word limit on club reports, but minor editing is done for typos, grammar, and continuity. The issue publication deadline is 3pm, US Central Time, on the Sunday, after the last Saturday of the month, before the month of issue.

If emails to you are returned, due to your box being full/over quota, or the address isn't valid, you won't receive notices on Modern Square releases or ASSDF club updates, until you contact me with updated info. Please let me know if you no longer want these emails.

Please CALL BEFORE TRAVELING, in case of last minute changes or cancellations. If you've been ill, feel ill on a dance night, or if weather is an issue, please stay home.

NONE of the ASSDF Officers will EVER send emails, Facebook messages, etc., asking for money, gift cards, etc.; those are SCAMS! Clubs with Facebook pages MUST police them, as scammers are posting things like "club T-Shirts", "death of a celebrity", "deleting all inactive members", "wanting part time work," (NOTHING to do with square dancing). These posts/emails have viruses to steal your identity, delete, destroy, or encrypt your data, where you'd have to pay a HUGE cost to get it back.

If you see these emails, DELETE them. And, if you see these ads, DON'T click on ANY part of them. Instead, report them to the group administrators, so the post can be deleted, and the poster can be banned from the group. Then, BLOCK that person in your email spam filter, and your Facebook profile. This helps keep that spam off your page. If not, someone will get their identity/data stolen, your Facebook page could get hacked, or you could be "left on the hook, financially".

10 tips for a great time:

Arrive on time. Being punctual helps you catch the first tip and keeps the dance floor flowing smoothly.

Dress for the occasion. Choose comfortable shoes and clothing you can move in. Traditional square dance attire is often encouraged, but neat, casual wear is always welcome.

Practice good hygiene. Dancing means close contact—fresh breath, clean hands, and fragrance-free choices make it pleasant for everyone.

Be warm and welcoming. Smile, make eye contact, and greet fellow dancers with kindness. A friendly floor is a happy floor.

Tune in to the caller. Listen closely and follow cues promptly. Avoid chatting during calls so everyone can hear clearly.

Hold your place. Stay in your square and maintain formation. If you get turned around, rejoin smoothly without disrupting others.

Encourage newcomers. Support beginners with patience and positivity. A little kindness goes a long way.

Dance gently. Use soft handholds and smooth movements. Square dancing is about cooperation, not competition.

Show appreciation. At the end of each



tip, thank your partner, the square and the caller. Gratitude is part of the tradition.

Enjoy yourself! Square dancing celebrates rhythm, community, and joy. Relax, laugh, and let the music move you.

TERESA BERGER

Teresa Berger grew up in the square dance activity and started calling in 2010. She calls and teaches square dancing through Plus, cues Rounds through Phase III, teaches Line Dances, and records for Rhythm Records. Teresa is a member of CALL-

JEREMY BUTLER

Jeremy and his wife Jamie live in Virginia Beach, VA. He started calling in 1996. He is the club caller for the Capitol Squares (A2/C1) in Richmond, VA, and The Square Edges (Plus) in Newport News, VA. Jeremy is also a traveling caller and calls for festivals and dances in many places around the country.

He is the current Advanced Program Committee Vice-Chairman, Applications Review Committee Chairman, a member of the Board of Governors in CALLERLAB, and is the Membership Committee Chair for the Virginia State Callers Association.

Jeremy has recorded for both Crown Records and Royal Records and calls the SSD program through C1.

MIKE SEASTROM

Mike Seastrom has been dancing since 1960 and calling since 1963. He lost a bet to his mother who insisted he try square dancing at least three times. The third time he was hooked. He taught his first class in 1963 after borrowing money from his parents to buy a small sound system. He was able to pay them back before the class was over and he's been calling ever since.

He calls and teaches Basic through C-1 programs, prompts Contras, teaches Line Dances, and enjoys dance party events when his schedule allows. Mike currently teaches for the Buckles & Bows Square Dance Club in Thousand Oaks, CA, and teaches the Social Square Dance program, which enables him to teach two classes a year plus a Summertime Funshop of SSD calls.

Calling has given Mike the opportunity to travel extensively in the United States, Canada, Sweden, Denmark, Norway, Germany, Costa Rica, New Zealand, Australia, and Japan. He said he feels "dancing as a team of eight" is the best recreation in the world. As a recently retired dentist, calling has been an avocation quite different from his "Dr. Mike" side. He added, thankfully, his wonderful wife Lisa, family, and staff have been tremendous support.

SHAWN BROWN



Shawn Brown was introduced to square dancing in 2009 and began calling less than a year later at age 14. In 2011, he called his first National Square Dance Convention* in Detroit, MI. In 2012, he became a recording artist for Gold Rush Records, becoming one of the youngest recording artists of the time. Today, he is a co-producer for Gold Rush Records, along with his father. Scott Brown.

Shawn works as a local and regional traveling caller, also traveling nationally, calling SSD through A2. He has called in 25 states, and in 2017 he called his first festival as a featured caller in Biloxi, MS, with Lisa Minton and Scott Brown. In 2023, he was blessed with the opportunity to work as a caller coach during the Grand Square International (GSI) Caller School in Mobile, AL.

Shawn joined CALLERLAB in 2011. He has been a presenter on several panels at CALLERLAB and NSDC conventions. He currently serves on the Caller Training, Mainstream, Marketing, and Music Producers committees.






What is Round Dance?

Many square dancers also enjoy round dancing, so you'll find plenty of round dance sessions at the 75th National Square Dance Convention®. If you're new to round dancing, here's a quick introduction:

Round dancing is a form of choreographed ballroom dance, where couples move in a counter-clockwise circle around the floor. Every step is prewritten on a cue sheet and called out in real time by a cuer, allowing all dancers to stay in sync.

Popular round dance rhythms include two step, waltz, foxtrot, cha-cha, rhumba, tango, and salsa. Each dance figure is assigned a difficulty level by Roundalab, the international organization that sets standards for round dancing.

75th NSDC's Leadership Certification Program

Interested in being a leader or learning to be a better one? Then the Leadership Certification Program is for you! The program can easily be completed during a single National Square Dance Convention® (NSDC) but you can take up to four years to finish. Upon completion you will receive a Certificate of Completion and a LCP dangle to proudly wear on your badge.

The Leadership Certification Program (LCP) consists of two mandatory classes, four core sessions, and two electives for a total of eight hours. There are around 43 hours of dancing and other activities during any NSDC so, if you start and finish the LCP, you



will still have around 35 hours to enjoy everything the Convention has to offer. However, if you are someone who loves taking classes, you can take as many as you wish as long as you get the basic number of each category completed.

The Mandatory Sessions include the Bid Session and the Keynote address. The Bid Session is an exciting presentation given by a state that wants to host an upcoming National Square Dance Convention. The presentation highlights many of the attractions in that city as well as providing information about the proposed venue. The second mandatory class is the Keynote Address given by a prominent member of the square or round dance community and addresses a timely and pertinent issue within the community. The Keynote Speeches can be so inspiring that participants leave with the knowledge they can make a difference.

Core Classes provide the participants with knowledge for effective administration of a square dance club or organization. These classes include insurance, using social media effectively, how to become a 501c3 organization, educational/informational pamphlets and videos available to clubs, various support organizations such as United Square Dancers of America (USDA), ARTS, and CALLERLAB as well as important topics of the current year.

Elective Classes cover a wide range of topics. Previous electives included seminars to help new callers build their skills, how to recruit and retain dancers, a slide presentation on the next year's convention, as well as seminars on making colorful and effective flyers, competition and exhibition square dancing, and histories of contra and square dancing.


