Prompt Renewal ... If you wait until the last minute to renew your subscription, or sign up for The Modern Square (including at a Subscription Dance very close to the 10th of the month preceding the month of issue), you may MISS one or more issues, and may NOT be able to get a copy of the missed issues, even if you had material published in it.

Remember ... If you do not contact the Circulation Manager when you have a delivery issue, then there is no way for him to rectify it. The problem may be in the database record or with the Postal Service. Both can be fixed.

Note ... The ONLY time that a dancer should contact the Circulation Manager regarding someone else’s subscription, is in the event of that person’s death, so that the subscription can be cancelled.



It is with deep regret that I report the passing of one of the individuals who did a lot for Arkansas square dancing years ago...Lloyd Wilson, who passed away on Aug. 24, 2018.

Lloyd, and his wife, Hazel, were some of the early members of the Arkansas State Square Dance Federation...serving both as ASSDF Presidents in 1962...and if I remember right...they started "The Modern Square" and were its first editors. When I told Lloyd that I was reading the copy that my Mom and I Dad had, he chided me for "reading a used Modern Square", and "to get a subscription of my own"...but this was back when there were well over 1000 subscribers to the publication.

Lloyd and Hazel were also members of two long gone central Arkansas clubs...the Twin City Stars, called for by the late "Wild Bill" Wilder...and the Star Promenaders, called for by Woody Ussery. The Twin City Stars Hobo Dance, and the Star Promenaders January Jamboree Dance, are fond memories of yours truly.

They got my Mom and my late father, Betty and J.D. Stout, into square dancing, and then I got into the hobby 3 years later. My parents quit dancing several years ago, and while I was out of the hobby for 5 years, I still subscribed to "The Modern Square" during that time.

I then was an employee at the family's silkscreen printshop for 18 years, until declining health forced my resignation.

God Speed, Lloyd...thank you for all you did for square dancing in Arkansas.


