

- 2) Club info (when/where they dance, regular or special dance, lessons, etc.).

If your email bounces back due to a bad address, you won't receive notices on releases of The Modern Square, or ASSDF club updates (special dances, last minute cancellations or changes etc.), until you contact the Editor with the corrected/updated email address. And, please advise the Editor if you no longer want these emails. The issue publication deadline is 9pm, US Central Time, on the last Saturday of the month, prior to the month of issue.

Please call before you travel, to check for any last minute changes or cancellations. If you feel ill on a dance night, or if bad weather/icy roads are an issue, please stay home.

Note that NONE of the ASSDF Officers will ever send an email, or a Facebook message, that is asking for money, gift cards, etc. -- those are nothing but scams!! Also, clubs with Facebook pages MUST be DILIGENT policing them; as scammers are posting things like "club T-Shirts", "deleting inactive members", "death of a celebrity", "looking for part time work", etc. (NOTHING related to square dancing). These posts are scams, filled with malware/clickbait, etc. to steal your identity, place malware on your system to delete, destroy, or encrypt your data, etc., where you'd have to pay a huge cost to get it back.

If you see these emails, DELETE them. And, if you see these ads, DON'T click on ANY part of them. Instead, report them to the group administrators, so the post can be deleted, and the poster can be banned from the group. Then, BLOCK that person in your email spam filter, and from your Facebook profile. I highly recommend that Facebook group administrators set it to "pre-approve" all posts, then automatically approve all future posts from recognized square and round dancers. This will help keep that spam off your page. If not, someone will get their identity or data stolen...or your page could be hacked!!



# Sets in Order - March 1966 squaredancespokane.org


- 1. Don't Attend They will have enough without you
- 2. **Don't Pay Your Dues** The club treasury is loaded. They don't need your money
- 3. **Ignore All Guests** You didn't invite them so why be nice to them?
- 4. **Dance Only With Your Own Clique** After all you are the only ones who know how to dance.
- 5. **Complain** Gee Whiz, can't they do anything right?
- 6. **Gripe About the Club Officers** But never, do anything to help.
- 7. **Never Serve on a Committee** And if you are put on one "nuts" to them.
- 8. **Deride the Caller** You know more about dancing than he does.
- Never Invite Guests It's too much trouble; but if you do be sure they are below the level of your club.
- 10. **Don't Learn Anything New** you know enough to get by; how can you be sure something new will be fun.
- 11. **Jabber and Talk While a Dance is Going On** You're not interested in what the caller is saying, so why should anyone else be.

To be honest, this chicken recipe might even be better than a ring.

#### MARRY ME CHICKEN

2 tablespoon olive oil
Pint of cherry tomatoes, cut in half
2 boneless skinless chicken thighs
3 cloves minced garlic
2 teaspoons dried oregano
1 teaspoon crushed red pepper
3 tablespoons of rad or white wine or water

3 tablespoons of red or white wine or water

1 cup chicken stock

3/4 cup heavy cream

To thicken sauce 2 teaspoons cornstarch + I tablespoon water Olives torn in half for garnish or capers

#### INSTRUCTIONS

Preheat oven to 400 degrees. Use a large skillet that can go from stovetop to oven, or a big oven friendly pot will also work.

Place tomato halves in skillet, drizzle with two tablespoon olive oil, and a pinch of salt and pepper and toss to combine. Place in the oven to roast for 15–20 minutes, stirring once. Roast until the tomatoes have sizzled off some of their water, and begin to brown slightly. Remove from skillet from oven and reduce oven temperature to 375 degrees. Transfer all the tomatoes to a small bowl. We will incorporate them later.

Season chicken on both sides with salt and pepper. Sear the chicken in same pan the tomatoes roasted in (no need to clean it). Add an additional couple tablespoons of oil to the pan and place over medium

high heat. Sear the chicken on both sides. Don't worry about cooking the chicken all the way through. It will spend more time in the over to cook through and tenderize. Place seared chicken in a bowl.

Reduce the heat to low. Add chopped garlic to pan, and stir constantly for 1 minute. Stir in oregano and red pepper flakes. return tomatoes to pan along with splash of wine.

Stir in chicken stock and heavy cream, and bring to a low simmer. Return chicken to pan, nestling them in sauce. Place the skillet in oven, and bake for 18-20 minutes.

Remove from oven, and thicken sauce. In a small bowl, whisk together cornstarch and water and whisk into the hot sauce in the skillet. If sauce doesn't thicken, place it over a low burner and whisk until thick, just a few minutes.

Return the chicken to the sauce and top with torn olive and fresh parsley. Serve over rice, pasta, couscous or potatoes.
