















Next, several photos from "The Three Amigos Start The Floor In 24" Dance on Jan. 6.

Following that, several photos from the dance, and of course, all the good food that was on the duty square.





























Next, a few photos from the Twirling Funtimers Cookies And Cocoa Dance, which was postponed a week, due to winter weather.







Next, several photos from a dance in Rolla, Missouri, where Pioneers Caller Roy Hestand, called the dance.


















Lastly, several photos from the Maverick Mixers Jan. 27, 2024 dance.





